

PLEASE DO NOT PATRONIZE BIG TUNA RESTAURANT IN GEORGETOWN, SC

WHEREAS Big Tuna restaurant owner, Bucky Watkins, appeared on the Charleston, S.C.-- TV 5 news and criticized the reopening of ArcelorMittal Georgetown Steel;

WHEREAS Watkins claimed that the Steel Mill is noisy and makes a lot of houses dirty;

WHEREAS Watkins stated his support for the Steel Mill to remain closed;

WHEREAS it is not in the best interests of the community to patronize any business that wishes ill on the employees of ArcelorMittal Steel in Georgetown, SC;

WHEREAS the members of the United Steelworkers (USW) Local 7898 unanimously passed a resolution on October 20, 2010 calling for a **BOYCOTT** of the Big Tuna restaurant located on Front St. in Georgetown, SC, by their membership, families and friends.
